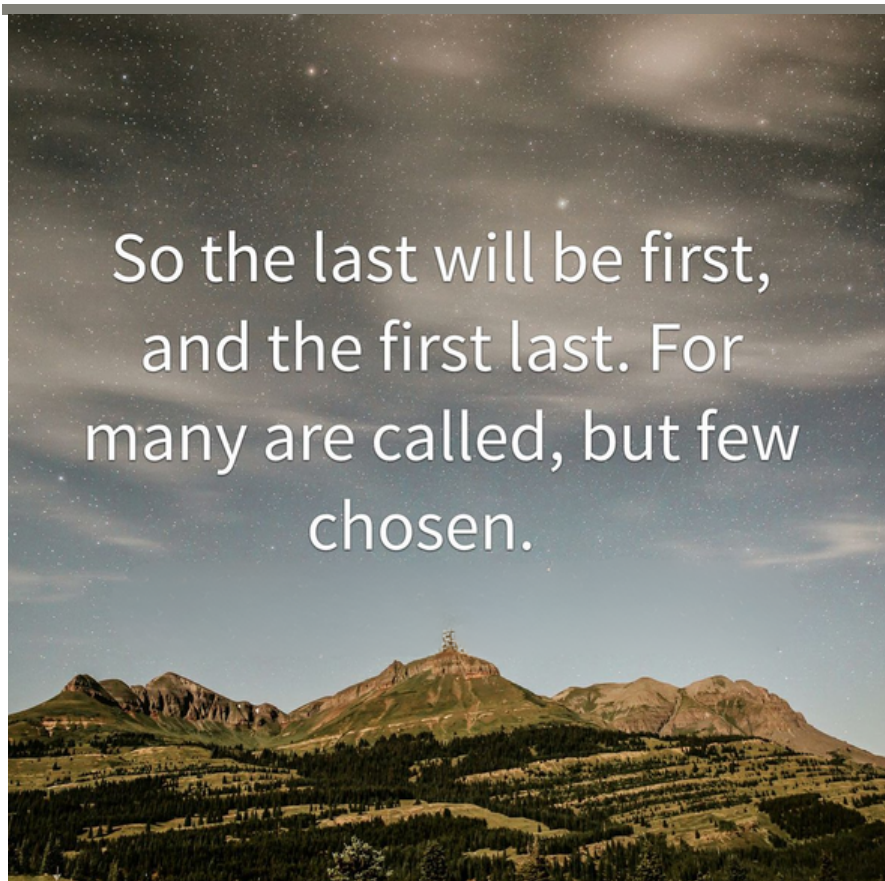

25th Sunday: Ultimate Reward

“Take your pay and go. I want to give the one who was hired last the same as I gave you. Don't I have the right to do what I want with my own money? Or are you envious because I am generous?” (Matthew 20: 14-15)

In life, we often want to have more than others and in this unhealthy struggle we fall into the trap of jealousy and envy. In envy we tend to forget our blessings and envy the blessings of other people. Envy is the act of casting an evil eye on the blessings of others and forgetting the heaps of blessings that God has given us. We look out of the corner of our eyes to what God is doing for others and fail to notice the good works he is doing in us. Envy is a symptom of lack of appreciation for what we have and who we are.

Maria Konnikova said, “No one would deny that feeling envy is unpleasant, or that feeling envious sometimes leads us down a path we wish we hadn't taken. Envy is frequently corrosive and destructive.”

In the gospel of Matthew 20: 1-16, the landowner paid the workers, not just for the number of hours they spent, but he paid them for their willingness to work and for completing the task given to them. This tells us that God reads our intentions; the Bible is punctuated with instances of these:

- Jesus praised the poor widow for giving all she had to live on. It was not about the amount she gave, but for the sacrifice she made. (cf. Mark 12: 41-44)
- Jesus pardoned the thief on the cross. It was not because of his last-minute confession, but for his sincere act of contrition. (cf. Luke 23: 40-43)
- The parable of the prodigal son is another good example of how God supplies grace to the unworthy, who are willing and ready to return to him. (cf. Luke 15: 11-32)

In God's radical generosity, it does not matter how long you have worked in the vineyard, but **how well**. It does not matter who comes first, but who offers him/herself sincerely. Whatever we receive from God is not an entitlement but a privilege.

Jean Vanier said, “Envy comes from people's ignorance of, or lack of belief in, their own gifts.” The gospel encourages us to be contented with what we have and to be happy for what other people have. Envy is one of the greatest spiritual challenges that obstruct the flow of the grace.

Some of the best ways to overcome this challenge is:

- To identify and accept God's generosity in our lives.
- To be happy for the prosperity and achievement of others.
- To learn to be generous, to think less of ourselves and support those in need who have less than we have.

Like the landowner, God gives the same ultimate reward to all who obey him. His ultimate reward is 'eternal life'. Actually, no human being by his/her own merit deserves to be blessed with life in heaven. It is, rather, the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross which has opened the gate of heaven for us. So, life in heaven is a reward exceedingly greater than what any human being deserves to receive by his/her efforts. So, God's reward of life in heaven is a generous gift to both the first-comers and the last-minute-comers. We are all precious in God's sight.
